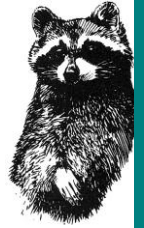


# Starsmore Discovery Center North Cheyenne Cañon Park

### ***Andy's Animal Senses***

**(Preschool- ages 3-5)**

Andy walks children through his world of touch, sight, smell and hearing. He introduces young explorers to his animal friends with special noses, paws, eyes and ears. This program features hands-on activities and a walk around Starsmore Discovery Center. (Cost \$3.00).1.0 hrs.

### **Junior Ranger Program**

**(Ages 8-12)**

### **Tipi Raising and Ute Heritage Workshop**

**(Grades3-6)**

This program involves packing a travois and setting up an authentic tipi and learning about the way of life of the native Ute People through interactive, hands-on experiences.

### ***Wildlife Habitats***

**(Grades 1-3)**

### ***Nature Detectives***

**(Grades K-2)**
